NO SHOTS. NO RECORD. NO SCHOOL!

Did you know Baltimore County Public Schools require:

- Two Varicella vaccines
 (Chicken Pox) for
 students entering
 grades K-9.
- A Tdap vaccine
 (Whooping Cough)
 and a Meningococcal
 vaccine (meningitis)
 for students entering
 grades 7-12.
- Scheduled immunizations administered by September 15, or student will not be allowed to return to school.

Start Administering Vaccines Early (S.A.V.E.)

Bring your child to a Baltimore County health center in your area to get needed shots, or make an appointment with your pediatrician as soon as possible.

Free vaccine is available for those who:

- Have Medical Assistance or MCHP
- Have no health insurance
- Have health insurance that does not pay for vaccine
- Are 18 years old or younger
- Attend a BCDH Mass Vaccine Clinic

Start Administering Vaccines Early (S.A.V.E.)
