Baptism Fact Sheet

Please arrive and check-in at the new, on-site STCF Baptismal Chapel by 12:00 p.m. promptly so we can ensure that all candidates have time to change into their baptism attire and are prepared for baptism that will start at 12:30 p.m. A brief class will take place before the service begins. The address for Set The Captives Free Outreach Center is below (near the bottom). - Invite your family and friends to witness your baptism.

- **The attire for baptism candidates is as follows:**
 - **Women:** White non-see-through tops, white slacks and white socks. **A bathing suit should be worn under your clothing**
 - **Men:** White shirts, white or khaki slacks and white socks **Swimming trunks should be worn under your clothing**
 - Teens same as above for your gender
 - (No hair gel, hairspray, oily hair products, makeup or earrings; this will help keep the pool free of debris.)
- **Additional items to bring with you:**

Bring a towel, a dark sheet to cover yourself after exiting the pool, and a change of clothing. The women may want to wear a bathing cap to keep their hair from getting wet.
- **Requirements:**

Baptism age is 9 years and older, must be saved or born again. Baptism is an outward sign of an inward work that has already taken place. Baptism does not save you - it confirms that you *are* saved. Baptism is also commanded by scripture, "Acts 2:38." *Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost. KJV*
